

Cadence Club Minutes Regular Meeting

February 3, 2015

Meeting Called to Order at 7:00 P.M.

Approval of Minutes - Chris Dean motioned to approve the last two months minutes (November 4 and December 2). Kym Waddell seconded, motion carried. The January CC meeting was cancelled because of a school snow day.

★President's Report - Paul Button

🗣️ Please keep the Ayscue family in your prayers. Their daughter, Catherine died last Tuesday. CC has made a donation in her name to the Knights of Columbus, where David is a member. A public memorial mass is scheduled Saturday, 12 noon at St Mary Catholic Church.

🗣️ Kym Waddell gave a spirit wear order for Judy Thompson to Mr. Doherty for distribution. An extra spirit wear sweatshirt was also given to Mr. Doherty to use as a give away item at the incoming freshman parent meeting. Jerianne Gooding has not received her spirit wear order.

🗣️ Stacey Ullom announced that the meeting was being audio recorded as a backup to prepare the minutes. The recording will be deleted once minutes are written up.

🗣️ Doug Waddell has volunteered to work with Mr. Doherty as webmaster to handle website updates. Kym will followup with Doug to schedule a meeting.

- Mary Bowe indicated Mr. Doherty could get an override from the school district for the Facebook access.
- Doug will be happy to manage the band on Twitter but not Facebook.
- Mary Bowe suggested Constant Contact for newsletter distribution which goes to email and Twitter. She has experience with this at Willis and is willing to assist with band notices.
- Jerianne Gooding suggested free text notices through Remind. Mr. Doherty said we can text through Charms and people do not need to subscribe, however there is an additional cost with Charms.

🗣️ Mr. Doherty reported on the Drum Clinic. The drummer has finished touring with Justin Timberlake. Columbus Percussion will help to promote our event and is very excited about the drummer coming to this area. Although an official date for the event has not been set, the school is aware of the plan to have the clinic in March. There is a trailer video on Tim Pence's Facebook page.

★Treasurer's Report - Kym Waddell

🗣️ The Budget Committee will meet this month and present a budget next month. Typically the committee consists of CC officers and a couple other interested CC members. Paul Button recommended Andy Cross and Jerianne Gooding. Kym will contact the committee members with meeting times and dates.

- Mr. Doherty will be using CL Designs again. CL Designs has been cleared by the police department and Mr. Doherty has received approval/clearance in writing from the district.

🗣️ January 2015 Beginning Balance \$24,443. Ending Balance \$24,443.

- Outstanding Balance \$20,627 includes a deposit of \$282 from Bob Evans. There have been no checks received or deposited from the Bingo fundraiser yet.

★Fundraising Report - Nan Dean

🗣️Bob Evans

- Nan indicated Bob Evans was thrilled with the amount of business (\$1800) CC brought in for them and would be happy to partner with CC again.

🗣️Bingo

- Three volunteers are needed on February 21 at 4 p.m. Two from 4-6:30 p.m. and one from 4-9:30 p.m. This is the same day as the All City Music Festival.
- Dee Hardison said the computer training was insufficient for her position at Bingo.

🗣️Electronics Recycling

- Nan will post recycling posters all around the school and the band website before February 6.
- Collection bins will be in the commons, the music hall and the front hall
- Items to bring are printer cartridges, cell phones, mp3 players, laptops, etc.
- Instructions to wipe them are on the band website.
- The collection will begin Friday, February 6 and finish after the All City Music Festival, February 21.
- Music Boosters has agreed to share this event with their contacts as well.

🗣️Crowd Funding

- Doug Waddell has the site up and running. The Waddell's made the first donation and CC received a donation from Susan White today.
- Chris Dean prepared a Thank You to be signed by students, first names only. Katie Waddell will obtain signatures tomorrow and pass it onto Emily Dean.

🗣️Chipotle, Mary Bowe

- Monday, February 16, 6-8 p.m. There is no school that day.
- CC will receive 50% of the sale if the flyer is presented with payment.
- Flyers will be distributed at the February 6 basketball game. The band will not play at the February 13 basketball game (no school).
- Dan Bartha will include the Chipotle fundraiser in the Hayes newsletter.
- Mary Bowe will send it district-wide to all employees.

🗣️Crew Stadium

- Sodexo contract was not renewed. Levy Restaurants is the new foodservice provider at Crew. Levy has a good reputation with OSU venues.
- Open house potentially next Thursday, Nan will attend.
- Alcohol training is online. Lead training will be different.
- Eight games plus ROTR have been identified to fit in best with the CC schedule:
 - March 14, 28 (If there is no MLS strike)
 - April 25
 - May 15,16,17 ROTR
 - June 6, 13
 - July 19, 25
 - October 25
- There will be new hats with the Crew's new logo.

🗣️Best Buy Fundraiser

- Purchase a \$10 card and get a \$25 gift card at one of 18,000 restaurants.
- Need to find out what CC would make and get the list of restaurants.
- This could be a possible band trip fundraiser.

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- Mr. Doherty suggested the Scripts program as an alternative for student band trip fundraising. Scripts would put sale credits into individual student accounts.

🗨️ Winter Guard Fundraisers

- Mr. Doherty will piggyback on the orchestra/choir candy sale March 9 for guard fundraising.
- Laurie Lendon handbag sale. Laurie could purchase items at cost. CC could sell at any price and receive the amount over the cost. Sales are online. CC would not need to buy any merchandise. This could be a good fundraiser for winter guard. The scale is smaller and it involves one time clearance items.

★ Nominating Committee

🗨️ Need three volunteers to serve on the Nominating Committee, one current board member and two at large members. Kym Waddell volunteered as the outgoing board member.

- Nan asked that CC members who are interested in serving on the Nominating Committee contact Kym by the end of this week.

- The committee will look for suitable candidates who are interested in serving as a CC officer/board member. Committee chairpersons will be determined at a later date.
- Stacey Ullom stated that although the bylaws allow her to continue a second year in her position as secretary, if the Nominating Committee finds a suitable candidate who would like to serve as secretary she would be willing to step aside and assist in other ways.
- Nan Dean stated she would continue as Fundraising VP as long as there are other volunteers that can manage individual projects. Fundraising is a big job and CC needs a Fundraising Committee.
- Paul Button stated he would continue as President if nominated or would continue to serve where needed.
- Jerianne Gooding stated that the Nominating Committee should look over the interested parties and come up with people that would be most successful in a position. We should be careful that qualified people are placed on the ballot. When it comes to voting, some members may not be familiar with all the names and it is important for the Nominating Committee to recommend appropriate candidates.

🗨️ Charms Training

- There is a training conference in Las Vegas in June for \$325.
- Mr. Doherty will attend a local training this Friday at the OMEA Conference and bring back extra copies of any written training material to share with Charms Helpers.

🗨️ Eighth graders are currently registering for classes. Mr. Doherty will have a good idea of the numbers within the next couple of weeks. He anticipates 19 incoming freshman.

- Nan Dean recommended we make a concerted effort to get the eighth grade parents to our CC meeting in May.

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- Paul Button asked that CC members greet all new parents with open arms and welcome them.

 - Mr Doherty liked having the students here for Friday practice and thought it was valuable practice time.
 - Dee Hardison recommended CC have two chairpersons for the food committee, particularly if CC will provide Friday meals.
 - Mary Bowe stated it was a lot easier to have students stay after school on Fridays rather than pick them up, feed them and get them back to school on time. Friday practice and meals were an advantage for most parents.
