Meeting Called to Order at 7:00 P.M.

Approval of Minutes - Nan Dean motioned to approve the February minutes. Trisha Gemberling seconded, motion carried.

★Treasurer's Report - Kym Waddell

Report of February 2015 month-end checking account balances, income and expenses was discussed. Noted:

- February Beginning Balance \$24,443. Ending Balance \$23,806. Register Balance \$21,477.
- Monies were recently deposited in the amount of \$1755 that included Chipotle \$517, Spiritwear \$300, Bingo \$550 and Crowd-rise \$50, fundraisers.
- The Treasurer's report is filed.

★Director's Report - Andy Doherty

Band is doing well despite all the cancellations for weather.

Cancellation of the All City Music Festival was very unfortunate.

May do a digital recording session for 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th graders to provide students a cool experience, allow parents to hear the preparation for performance and maybe make a little money. Students were doing a really incredible job with preparation.

Symphonic Band will perform early morning Saturday, March 14 at OMEA contest. Times will be sent out as soon as we learn them.

Mr. Notestine reported 9 ensembles and 4 solos will perform April 18 at Gallion. The large group performance will be May 8 or 9. The 7th and 8th grade concert will be May 4.

Mr. Doherty reported that planning and design of the next marching season began one month ago and already two movements of music are completed. John is our composer/arranger. He is known for the OSU space show. Details of the Hayes show will be announced late April, early May.

Summer rehearsals will begin before the July 4 parade. There will be no June rehearsals. The stadium will be complete June 15. The band will practice in the stadium the majority of July. Another practice location will be needed in August when the sports teams will be using the field.

Drum Clinic. The drummer is currently touring with Madonna. We are not sure when the Hayes drum clinic will occur. It won't be March. It may be before the end of August.

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★Fundraising Report - Nan Dean

📍Bingo

- Three volunteers are needed on March 28 at Willis. Marlene DeWitt volunteered. Two remaining volunteers are needed from 4-6:30 p.m.

📍Electronics Recycling

- The music festival was cancelled so we are still collecting.
- Collection bins are outside the band room.

📍Crowd Funding

- Will be sending notices out again on Facebook, Charms and Hayesband. Donations are going toward the general fund now and we may change it to a specific designation.

📍Restaurant Fundraisers

- \$517 received from Chipotle fundraiser. Thank you Mary Bowe for taking the lead organizing this event.
- Considering a Donato's fundraiser in conjunction with NCAA basketball tournament starting March 19. Flyers are not necessary with mention and multiple dates are acceptable. CC would receive 20% of proceeds for sales up to \$500 and 30% of proceeds for sales over \$500.
- Mr. Doherty is planning a BDubs dine in as well.

📍Crew Stadium

- Sodexo contract was not renewed. Levy Restaurants is the new foodservice provider at Crew and they have set many new limits such as:
 - No workers under the age of 18
 - 20-25 adults needed to work each date.
 - New fees for workers per event - parking, laundry, etc.
 - Penalty charge of \$20 per person for each person short of a fully staffed stand.
 - One positive is alcohol training is quickly done online.
 - CC has decided to no longer work the Crew Stadium fundraiser.

📍Foertmyer and Sons

- Spring flower sale. Would include 8th grade band. Students would sell for 2-3 weeks and plants would arrive early May. A later delivery would likely be lesser quality.
- Average profit is \$5 per item.
- Others have experience with this fundraiser and it has been lucrative.
- Supporting a local business is an added benefit.
- Mary Bowe mentioned the district policy against multiple groups doing the same fundraiser at different schools.
- Mr. Doherty has scheduled a Yankee Candle fundraiser beginning March 12 with delivery in April that CC should work around.
- A lot of help would be needed upon delivery of plants. Students and parents can volunteer together.

🗣️Mr. Doherty confirmed the band trip will be Spring Break 2016. Details of the itinerary are not available yet. The band will go to Disney and travel by bus. Mr. Doherty will poll parents via Charms about leaving the Thursday before spring break or the Monday after Easter.

🗣️Community Outreach. Nan Dean explained the need for building a greater community presence to develop community support and corporate sponsorships for the band.

- Betsy Lenhart volunteered to pursue having the Chamber Winds play at the Delaware Arts Festival.
- Stacey Ullom volunteered to pursue opportunities for the band to play at select First Fridays.
- Mary Bowe volunteered to pursue having band members play at the HUB, a Friday middle school social program at Grace Brethren Church.
- Mr Doherty suggested we invite the community to all concert band performances.
- Nan said a tip/donation box would depend on the setting but a tent sign with the CC Crowd-funding site would be displayed.
