## Safety Procedures for Classroom Activities

### Rehearsal Space

- We will utilize the following areas for rehearsal. Please check the white board at the entrance for your rehearsal location
  - 3006 - Winds
  - 3005 - Winds
  - 3008 - Percussion

### Flow Pattern

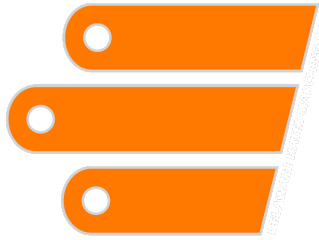
- Use the main music suite entrance into 3005 or 3006
- Use the nearest entrance to the instrument storage area (marked with arrows)
- All instrument storage areas are one way traffic
- All band/orchestra students will exit through the back double doors (near the outside doors) in 3006.
- Students in the 3005 will exit through the music library into 3006, and out the same back doors

### Instrument and Music Storage

- You may not leave your instrument in the music suite past your cohort days.
  - Ex: In week 1, Cohort A student can bring their instrument on Monday, leave it overnight and bring it home on Tuesday. They cannot leave their instrument at school until Monday
  - Exceptions: Large Instruments (Tuba, Euphonium, Trombone, Low Reeds, Bass, Cello) may store their instruments in their storage area at any time
- You may only use your assigned locker
- The only item permitted in your instrument locker is your instrument. Absolutely nothing else is permitted in your instrument locker
- You are not permitted to use empty lockers as extra storage
- No music will be stored at school. All music must go home with you every day.

### Masks and Sanitation

- Masks are to be worn at all times
- Wash masks regularly
- Sanitize hands as you enter
- Sanitize hands as you exit



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- Do not touch another student's instrument or equipment.
- Ask for help if you need to move something
- Brass should empty water key's onto their puppy pad and dispose of it at the end of the class

## Restrooms

- All students must check with staff AND sign out on the restroom logs provided for each classroom.
- Students should only use the restroom if absolutely necessary. This is an issue of contact tracing.
- Students will not be sent to the main office or counseling for any reason. If you forgot your instrument or folder that day, you are out of luck.

## Awareness

- Music students will need to be hyper-aware of their ability to spread the virus. By nature of our activity, our often flexible learning environment and our close relationships (you know, all the stuff we love about music!), we are super-spreaders.
- We have to be ultra-cautious in our interactions and our behaviors.
