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Hello Band Families!

Attached is our first information blast about our upcoming Disney Trip! We have been working hard with Bob Rogers Travel to create a unforgettable trip! **I would love to invite parents and students to our informational meeting on Thursday, March 10th at 7pm in the hayes band room.** We will go over expectations, the itinerary, medical questions, and any other questions or concerns about the trip. Mike Crandall, our trip planner, will be in attendance to go over the itinerary and give you an inside look at the trip. Shasta McKee (the Hayes Nurse) will also be at the meeting to field any questions about medicine that you may have. She will also be joining us on the trip if you would like to speak to her about your specific medical situation.

I have included an emergency medical form, and a permission to administer medicine form. **These attached forms should be completed and returned to Mr. Doherty no later than March 14th. If you have prescription medicine that will be taken on the trip, the medicine must be turned in no later than March 21st.** Please be sure that all contact info is correct, and that all healthcare items are up to date before turning in these forms. **If you have already turned in an emergency medical form, please submit it again.** You can never be too careful when traveling cross-country and we would like to be sure that we have all of the correct and up to date paperwork.

We have also included a permission slip for the bus to watch PG-13 movies on the ride. Please check your preference and include the slip with the medical information. The buses will have wifi, but may not have electric ports.

Finally, we have attached a quick FAQ that should cover some of your questions leading up to the meeting. # FAQ

## Medicine

- Food Allergies
  - We have the records of all food allergies and triggers for the trip. Bob Rogers has done a great job of planning multiple places for students to eat over the trip to avoid common allergies, but families are still encouraged to talk to their children about what to look for at restaurants to avoid any allergic reactions.
  - All students that require an epi-pen are encouraged to carry one on their person at all times. The directors and Mrs. McKee can hold onto an additional epi-pen if you wish.
  - Students may **not** carry and administer their own prescription medicine. All prescription medicine must be administered by Mrs. McKee, Mr. Doherty, or Mr. Notestine.

## Food and Spending Money

- All full meals are included in the trip costs. Your child will be handed a gift card/cash before each meal to use specifically on that meal. Any overages are at the child's expense. Each gift card is roughly \$25 (gift cards will be for dining at the Disney Parks, cash for on the road travel).
- Breakfast is provided at the hotel on Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday.
- The only spending money you require is for additional snacks, souvenirs etc.

## Emergency Contacts

- Students will be permitted to carry cell phones at all times, you may contact them whenever you wish.
- Mr. Doherty and Mr. Notestine's cell phone numbers will be given out prior to the trip as emergency contacts. We are staying at Holiday Inn Resort - Lake Buena Vista, the phone number is (407) 239-4500
- Students should carry some form of identification on them at all times (Ohio license, student ID, etc.)
- We will have a security guard patrolling our hallways at night.

## Luggage

- Students are permitted **one** medium to large suitcase.
- Students are permitted **one** small carry on bag.
- **We will be taking all of our instruments on the bus, so DO NOT OVERPACK. Please,** be smart about what you bring! A suggested items list will be given out at the meeting on March 10th.
