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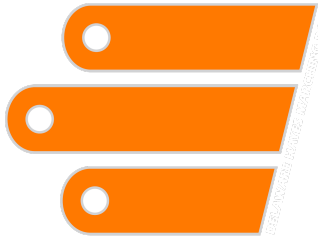

## Football Friday Nite Week 3 (9/25)

Thank you for your patience while we developed a new plan. We are excited to announce that for our third home game, **the entire band will be in the stadium for the entire game!** We are excited for this opportunity and can't wait to perform! Please **carefully read the entire document**, there are many changes for this week.

### Overview

- Uniform
  - Students will wear our 2020 Member shirt.
  - Students will wear jeans and athletic shoes.
  - Students may wear a black long sleeve layer under their member shirt
  - Students may wear jackets or sweatshirts while in the stands
- Performance
  - We will **not** be performing pre-game
  - We **will** play music for all four quarters of the game
  - Halftime will work as it has the previous two games.
- Attendants
  - Our stadium holds a socially distant crowd of roughly 250 spectators. Our band size is 116 members. This means that we cannot offer tickets to everyone that would like one. We are able to offer 116 tickets to the band.
  - **Senior member's families** will be able to purchase **two** tickets to the game.
  - Freshmen-Junior families will be able to purchase **one** ticket to the game.
  - **Each member is still permitted two "Guests of the Band" to enter for FREE during halftime!**

    - Only submit **ONE form per member.** In the event that multiple forms are submitted per member, we will only honor the first request by timestamp.
    - Tickets will be purchased through the athletic department and your name will be kept on file at the gates. (subject to change)

## Practice

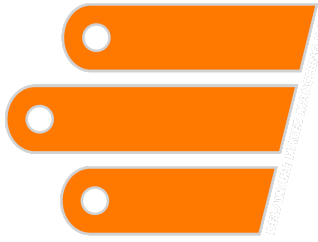
- Check in at the practice field outside of the band room
- After checking in, grab your instrument and head to the area where we march into the stadium—remain socially distant

## Section Picnic

- We will be doing a section picnic on Friday for dinner!
- Food rules
  - **No combined meals!**
    - Ex: pizza, b dubs etc.
  - You must either pack your own dinner or have one delivered to you. No students are permitted to leave campus to get a meal.
  - If you are planning on having a meal delivered for your section, they must be **individually wrapped and individually bagged.**
  - Section leaders may arrange some group items (bags of chips, pop) but they must be **pre-packaged**
- Bring a blanket or something to put on the grass
- **You must remain socially distant at all times.** If sections do not remain socially distant, offending parties will be sent home and **will not perform at the game.**

## The Game

- Spectators will remain in their seats for the duration of the game and remain socially distant. Tickets will be purchased through the athletic department and your name will be kept on file at the gates. (subject to change)
- Guests of the band (entering at halftime) will still enter for free!
- The band setup will be announced later this week
- The halftime performance will continue as normal



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- Students must remain seated the entire game
- There are two options for the band at this game
  - Option 1
    - The band is split between the home and visitor band stands. One half of the band will play for the 1st and 2nd quarter and the other half will play for 3rd and 4th quarter
    - This allows us to remain socially distant and not overtake the space from needed by the football teams for halftime (no locker room access)
  - Option 2
    - If we are able to safely fit, we will use the home band stand area and play for the entire game.
    - This will depend on the measurements we will take this week
